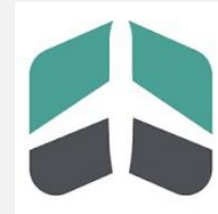

Overview

The Burbank-Glendale-Pasadena Airport Authority oversees operations at Hollywood Burbank Airport, a medium-hub (C-index) airport serving approximately 6 million passengers annually. The Airport Fire Department responds to a wide range of emergencies with specialized Aircraft Rescue and Firefighting (ARFF) capabilities.

Pre-Interview

Candidates who successfully complete the department pre-interview will be invited to an oral panel interview in March 2026.

Experience Requirement

- Five (5) years of municipal, county, state, or federal firefighting experience.
